## The artists

The Hungarian **Auer String Quartet** has won many prizes and wide international acclaim since its formation in 1990. It is a pleasure to welcome this quartet back to Milngavie.

The London based **Agon Piano Trio** was formed in 2004, the members having met during their studies in Moscow and London. Their many UK appearances include a 2007 residency at the Aldeburgh Festival.

**illuminati** are a dynamic young wind quartet formed three years ago from students of the RSAMD, since when they have enthusiastically explored the wind quartet repertoire. They are well known for their rapport with audiences.

The prize-winning pianist **Roger Owens** is one of the most versatile of performers. A skilled communicator with an engaging personality, he is a popular performer in the UK and beyond.

**Alexander Robin Baker**, baritone and prize winner in the 2008 Kathleen Ferrier Awards, and the pianist **Alasdair Young** who lives in Bearsden, are both currently studying at the Guildhall School of Music.

'Probably the best young string group in Europe' according to the Times (2007), the French **Psophos String Quartet** has rapidly established its reputation in the UK and Europe. **Nils Mönkemeyer**, born 1978, has already developed a remarkable career as a solo violist.
